Parking

There is no parking on site at Holmedale Health. However there are numerous "two hour" bays in Denmark Road and the immediately surrounding streets. Next to these is normally an unrestricted bay which you can use and a residents bay which you can only use with a permit. In addition there are two public car parks, one at each end of Denmark Road a few minutes walk away.

If driving from the East (A30):

The A30 joins the M5 at junction 29. Leave at this junction and follow the Honiton Road into Exeter, heading for the City Centre. After a couple of miles you will see Exeter Central Police Station on your right. Just past here on the left, take a left turn into Spicer road. If you follow Spicer Road around to the end there is a "T" junction with Denmark Road and Holmedale Health is opposite you, slightly to the right.

If driving from the North (M5):

From the M5 southbound leave at junction 29 signposted to Honiton. Follow the instructions as for A30 East.

If driving from the West (A30):

Proceed towards Exeter on the A30 from Okehampton. Turn off at the junction marked Exeter and Crediton A377. Follow this road into the city until you reach the Exe Bridges "roundabout". Take the Western Way (A3015, straight on) and follow this until it turns sharply left soon after passing the Magdalen Chapter Hotel on your right. As you bear left, take the right turn at the junction into Magdalen Road. On your left is the Fairpark public car park. Denmark Road is approximately 100 metres further on the left and Holmedale Health is some 200 metres along Denmark Road, also on the left.

If driving from the South (A38/380):

Follow the A38 or A380 towards Exeter. Leave at junction 31 and turn into the A30 Westbound and continue for approximately two miles. Turn off at the first exit marked Exeter and Crediton A377 and follow instructions for visitors from the West.
